Our 2013 Special Honoree - Sgt. Mike Cain

Mike lost his right leg when the Army truck he was driving detonated a land mine in Irag in 2003.

Over the last 10 years, he's had 70 surgeries to keep his left leg over the last 10 years. If the one last month does not work, it will have to be amputated.

Mike just wants a truck, one adapted for him to drive whether it is with one leg or none, so he can drive his daughter, be free to travel on his own, and get to his sled ice hockey games.

2012 Awardee - Sgt. Luis Rosa-Valentin

With the help of sponsors and participants in 2012 Picnic, Faces Of Valor USA completed adapting a home for this triple amputee (e.g., putting in an elevator) and decorating two bedrooms for his girls.



Luis back home with his two girls, Mili and Bella. His wife left unable to cope with his injuries.

Luis was born and raised in Maryland and graduated from Meade High School.

During his second deployment in Iraq, two days before his 25th birthday, Luis assisted an injured buddy to a medi-vac chopper. While returning to his unit, an IED exploded directly next to him – killing his best friend, Steve, and immediately amputating both legs and left arm, taking away his hearing and some of his sight, and leaving him unconscious and near death.

It took immediate life saving measures to stabilize him and finally get him to Walter Reed Army Medical Center – where he remained for nearly a year and a half.

2011 Awardee - Sgt. Tristan Brown

With the help of sponsors and participants in 2012 Picnic, Faces Of Valor USA provided a Volkswagen Jetta so that his wife, Merrilynn could get to work and he could get to Walter Reed for treatments and physical therapy

Tristan was born and raised in West Virginia and has returned there.

Weeks after he, his wife, and 4 month old daughter were relocated to Germany by the Army, Tristan deployed to Afghanistan for Operation Enduring Freedom. There, his humvee struck a pressure plate IED. A medi-vac chopper took him to safety; later, he was flown to Germany for a traumatic brain injury and other injuries.

It took 6 months of daily therapy at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, before the Army docs "found me fit to return to duty and to continue to serve my country!"

2010 Awardee - Sgt. Eric Edmundson

With the help of sponsors and participants in 2010 Picnic, Faces Of Valor USA started a College Trust Fund with an initial \$5000 for his 5 year old daughter, Gracie, which will be added to over subsequent years

Eric was born and raised in North Carolina and has returned there for support by family.

On patrol with his Army unit in Iraq, Erik was hit by a roadside bomb. While awaiting transport to Germany, Eric went into cardiac arrest and lost oxygen to his brain for 30 minutes, resulting in an anoxic brain injury.

Two years later, with military approvals, Eric went to RIC for acute inpatient rehabilitation. As with all traumatic brain injury patients at RIC, a customized treatment program was developed, including several brain and spine surgeries. He began to set goals for himself that would allow him to take back his quality of life, which took another two years.
